All four groups opened my eyes to seeing how true discipleship works in this community.

It has been a busy first month for me, but one filled with immense joy. As I mentioned in my introduction before each Mass my first weekend here, I am excited to be here, to be with all of you on your spiritual journey and to journey, as a community of disciples of Jesus Christ, to grow in our discipleship together.
